1. Is the Son of God the power, owner and absolute authority of all creation?
2. Is the Son of God the efficient cause of creation's existence?
3. Is the Son of God the basis for the creation of the earth?
4. Was the earth ever given to the jurisdiction of mankind (Gen. 1:28-29)?
 - Could this be a part of the reason Satan tempted mankind?
5. Was the earth created to be dependent upon the heavens in order to be fruitful for the needs of mankind?
 - Is that which is visible and physical created to be dependent upon that which is transparent and immaterial?
 - Does fruitfulness require dependence?
6. Is your idea of the earth one of plenteousness, strength, and obedience agreeing and submitting itself to the wisdom and power of God?
 - Or, is your idea of the earth that of emptiness, weakness, and sinfulness resisting the wisdom and power of God?
7. Was the Son of God the means and power by which the sky was created as we see it?
 - Was the Son of God the means by which outer space was created as we know it?
 - Was the very place of God's throne or residence created by the power of the Son of God?

8. What will happen to the visible and physical things created by the Son of God?
9. Will the Son of God ever perish?
10. Do the visible and physical things that were created have an aging process in them?
 - How did this happen concerning the aging and death process?

(Hebrews 1:12)

11. Can the Son of God change or transform the visible and physical things of creation of His power?
 - Does the Son of God ever change or come to an end?
 - Does transformation of the things we see and know as creation have an end to them?

Have you been transformed? Do you have an old way of living that has perished or been destroyed by the power of the Son of God?

Even in the aging and death process, do you see the process of change that leads to an end of a certain way of living?

- If the Son of God has never changed, is He now as He has always been?
- How can He be Savior and Lord?
- How can He be submissive and yet the Ruler of all things?
- Is He your deliverer and your absolute authority?
- Is your dependence upon the Son of God for deliverance and the ability to be submissive, or is it just for deliverance?
- Does deliverance relate to birth and submission to life after birth?
