

(Hebrews 1:13)

1. Did God ever command an angel to sit on the throne beside Him until He made the angel's adversary submit to the angel?

- Has an angel ever taken on the appearance of a man?
- Can a person take on an appearance of being someone that he is not?
- Can a woman appear as a man or a man appear as a woman?
- Because someone appears as something, does that mean that that is what they are?
- Is there a difference in appearing as something and actually being made something?
- Has it ever been said by God that an angel was born of a woman?
- If an angel of God can appear as a man, could a fallen angel or demon appear as a person? (See II Cor. 11:13-15.)
- Has Satan ever entered into a person and through that person appeared as something that he was not? (See Jn 6:70 and LK. 22:3-4.)
- Has it ever been said by God that the Son of God was made flesh or a human being rather than just appearing as a human being? (See Jn 1:1-14 - Read vs. 14 very carefully. See also Luke 1:26-35.)
- Has Satan by his spirit through mankind become the god of this world? (See II Cor. 4:4 – Through the mind or mental dispositions of people, Satan has opposed the Spirit of Christ preaching through His messengers. See also Eph. 2:1-2.)
- Was it necessary for the Son of God to become a human in order to have victory over Satan?
- In spiritual warfare, does victory come from a position of authority, a position of equality, or a position of submission?
- If Satan had gained the victory over mankind to become the god of this world, did he do it from a position of authority over the man? Was it from a position equal to the man, or did he come from a position that was placed under the jurisdiction of the man?
- If the Son of God was made a man, was He then through birth placed under the jurisdiction of Satan?
- Does victory over the heart of mankind come from the position of submission? Why did Satan approach Eve from the position of the serpent? Did Satan approach Adam from the position of the woman?
- Did God approach Satan from the position of a man?
- Did God defeat Satan's position of God through the body of a man? If yes, then can Jesus be our God in this world right now?
- Can we have His Spirit in our mind/heart that can overcome Satan's spirit in our thoughts?

- Do you use the position of submission as the effective beginning of victorious spiritual warfare?
- Has God ever intended to make His enemies submit to Him through one of His created angels or through His own self by the life that came out of Himself?

2. Could angels be the invisible and powerful force who help God's public servants in carrying out their religious duties or performance of service that is a benefit to the those they serve?

- Where would you say the power of a servant is found?
 1. Who he is? Or 2. In what he says? Or 3. In what he does?
- Where was Jesus' power?
 1. In who He was? Or 2. In what He said? Or 3. In what He did?
- Is a person's power in his blood or in his breath?
- If angels are servant spirits, how can their power be shown to benefit the ones they serve?
- In the original language of the Scriptures in the N.T., the word angel can be used interchangeably between the heavenly beings and earthly pastors. How can this be?
- If God sends forth the angels as invisible, powerful servants to serve those who are to obtain safety, deliverance, and preservation of eternal life, how could a person identify this service?
- Do you feel that God is constantly approaching you in conviction of sin and your need to yield to Him?
- Do you experience the preacher preaching to just you in a crowd?
- Do you sense God is dealing with you through your guilt when you hear God's Word being preached?
- If you feel God is drawing you through the preaching or testimony of His Truth? Could this be the ministry of God's messengers?
- Do you feel or sense that you have the spiritual help of being safe and secure in a world of insecurities?
- Do you experience God delivering you out of every trouble while you submit to His commands and direction for your life?
- Do you experience God's preservation while you continually work at the appointed service to Him in the lives of other people?
- Do you sense that you have life that will never end?
