

**(Hebrews 1:4)**

1. What is the difference between life that God created and life that came forth out of God Himself?
2. Was the Son of God brought forth superior in power and strength in comparison to angels?
3. Was the Son, by being a direct descendant, given a superior description, authority, and dignity in comparison to the angels?
4. Was the Son given a title that was far more distinguished, honorable and superior than the angels? (See also Eph. 1:20-21 and Phil. 2:9-11.)

**(Hebrews 1:5)**

5. Did God ever say the following to any of the created heavenly host?

Yes/No    You are my offspring.

Yes/No    You are a life that came forth out of Me.

Yes/No    There was a certain day that you were brought forth out of me.

Yes/No    I will be as a Father to you.

Yes/No    You shall be as a Son who reveals the maturity of My exact image.

7. Is there any angel that was given a title that reveals his relationship with God as the Son does?
8. Is there any angel with a title that reveals his voluntary submission in fulfill the purpose of redemption as the Son does? (See also Ps. 2:7-12.)

**(Hebrews 1:6)**

9. Furthermore, when God introduced the life which came out of Him through the lower life form of human flesh, what did God command the angels in heaven to do? (See Jn. 1:1,14; Col. 1:13-18; Rev. 1:5-8.)
10. Can you have reverence without submission?
11. Is submission the strongest act of reverence?

12. Is submission an expectation of God upon the life He created and in the order in which He created it?
13. Is the spirit of rebellion produced by a mental disposition that thinks in terms of equality?

**(Hebrews 1:7)**

14. What did God say about the angels?
  - a. Did God create angels to be messenger/servants endowed with the qualities of invisible, immaterial, and powerful spirits?
  - b. Did God say that He created angels to be servants as active and powerful as a flame of fire?
15. Have angels ever been recorded as having appearances and messages that enlightened people to God's intentions? (See Lk. 1:10-20, 26,37.)
16. Is it written that angels are active and powerful servants in carrying out God's judgments upon mankind? (See Rev. 16.)
17. Are these powerful beings to worship and serve the Son of God?
