1. Is it necessary to retain or hold on to the truth of the facts given in Hebrews chapter 1? Why?
2. Is held facts of truth or God's Word the unshakeable stability of one's beliefs?
3. Should one frequently rehearse or repeat facts of truth in his mind in order to retain his effort of devotion?
4. Do you think there is a difference in hearing with the physical ear and hearing with the ear of the understanding?
5. Do you think that something is easier to remember if it is thought of and shared repeatedly with others?
6. How can you lose or allow facts of truth to get away from you?
  - How do past facts of your beliefs become changed into different facts of truth?
7. Explain to yourself how you allow sermons, Sunday school lessons, Bible readings, etc. to pass without giving serious attention to them.
  - How much truth do you suppose God has sent to you through His Word but you did not give enough serious attention to it to retain it?
8. Do God's messages of salvation come before God's judgments?

**(Hebrews 2:2)**

9. What does the Bible say about the words that God's servant messengers (angels) speak in chapter 2:2?
  - What does "steadfast" mean?
10. What does the word "transgression" mean?
  - Or disobedience?
  - What do you think a "just recompense of reward" means?
11. Is careless or inattentive listening an act of disobedience?
12. Do you think that the coming judgments of God upon your life are in direct proportion to the messages He has sent to you?
13. When you go to hear a sermon, do you go with the intention to hear and apply or just to hear, or do you just go because you are expected to go?

**(Hebrews 2:3)**

14. How can a person avoid the judgment of God if he is careless with the messages from God?

- Can a person escape judgment of God if he does not make a definite decision based on the message from God?

15. What does the Bible mean about “so great salvation” in Hebrews 2:3?

- Do you want to be in the place of God’s safety?
- Do you want to experience the power of God’s deliverance?
- Do you want to rest in God’s constant preservation?

16. How does the Lord confirm, prove to be trustworthy the message He has given from the beginning?

- Can you explain to another person the answer to #15? Did you?
- Can you explain to another person the answer to #16? Did you?

17. Can a person be preserved in God’s unending favor and acceptance?

18. How does God give evidence to prove the messages or that His sent truth is trustworthy?

19. What are “divers miracles?”

20. In these Scriptures, what is the reason for the gifts of the Holy Ghost?

- Are the abilities given by God’s Holy Spirit to further prove that the message of the Word of God or the Bible is true and worthy of trust in its given facts?
- If you answered yes to this question, then explain to another person your life and how the evidence of your belief has worked in the life of another or in the difficult circumstance you have been through.
- Has your explanation of truth ended all doubts in another person about his outcome in God’s coming judgments?
