- How can you labor to enter into God's rest or finished work?
- How can you be sure you have avoided the fall of unbelief?
- How can you make your calling and election sure? (See II Peter 1:3-10.)
- What can you focus your effort toward in order to eliminate uncertainty, doubt or rejection concerning your sin before God?
- How can you be sure that all your sins are forgiven?
- Did Jesus die for only the sins you have committed in the past or all the sins of your entire life span?
- Which of your sins are covered by the blood of Jesus Christ?

Hebrew 4:12

- What is God's Word?
- Is it an expression of His intelligence?
- What does it mean that God's Work is quick?
- How is it powerful?
- Why is it compared to a two-edged sword?
- Can there be a discernable difference between a person's soul and spirit?
- Can there be a discernable separation or difference between the moral outward being and the spiritual inward being?
- What does it mean when it says the Word of God is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart?

Hebrew 4:13

- What does the Word of God have to do with you being naked and open to the eye of God Himself?
- What does it mean that every being is fully known in God's sight?
- Can the Word of God reveal the hidden qualities of you toward yourself?
- Does this mean that if you discover yourself by the Word of God that you are finally seeing what God has always seen?
- Have you ever had the experience of God revealing your hidden qualities to you or letting you see yourself the way He sees and knows you?

Remember Matthew 7:21-23: These people did not see themselves in the same way Jesus did.
