 - Does a person reject God before God rejects them? (See Isaiah 5:1-7.)

Hebrews 6:9

- Who are the "beloved" opposite to in this verse?
 - How can a person be persuaded of better things concerning the beloved?
 - Who are the beloved?
 - What are the things that accompany salvation?

Hebrews 6:10

- In this verse how do believers show their love to God's name?
 - Does God really remember every effort and labor of love accomplished by a believer?
 - How would you explain the labor of love out of this verse to someone who did not know or understand?
 - Do we really show love toward the Lord by how we minister to those who have been transitioned from sinners to saints?
 - Where do you think people in the Church today seek to express the love for the Lord most? To the world or to the saints of the Lord?
