- What are we to consider about Melchisedec?

**Hebrews 7:5**

- Were men appointed to the position of priest instructed to accept tithes from their brethren according to the law?
- What exactly does the law say about the tithe? (See Numbers 18:21-32.)
- What do you think it means in this verse by the statement "though they come out of the loins of Abraham?"

**Hebrews 7:6**

- Why then did Abraham give a tenth of tithe to a priest who was not a descendant of the Levitical priesthood?
- How could Melchisedec's blessing be effective toward the promise God made to Abraham?

**Hebrews 7:7**

- How could Abraham be considered the lesser between him and Melchisedec?
- What does it mean in Abraham's case about being blessed?
- What does it mean about Melchisedec being the better?

**Hebrews 7:8**

- In this verse, what is the difference between the Levitical priesthood and Melchisedec in receiving tithes, and what do you believe is being indicated?

**Hebrews 7:9-10**

- The Levitical priesthood received tithes from their brethren, and how were they credited in paying tithes?
- Does this type of credit in paying tithes apply to anyone other than the Levitical priesthood?
- Do you believe that people today should still support the ministry of God with at least a tenth giving of their income? Do you do this?
- Do you believe there is still a blessing in the giving?
- Again, what do you believe Abraham's giving of a tenth indicated about the one considered greater than himself?
